- Want to innovate but are not sure exactly where to start.

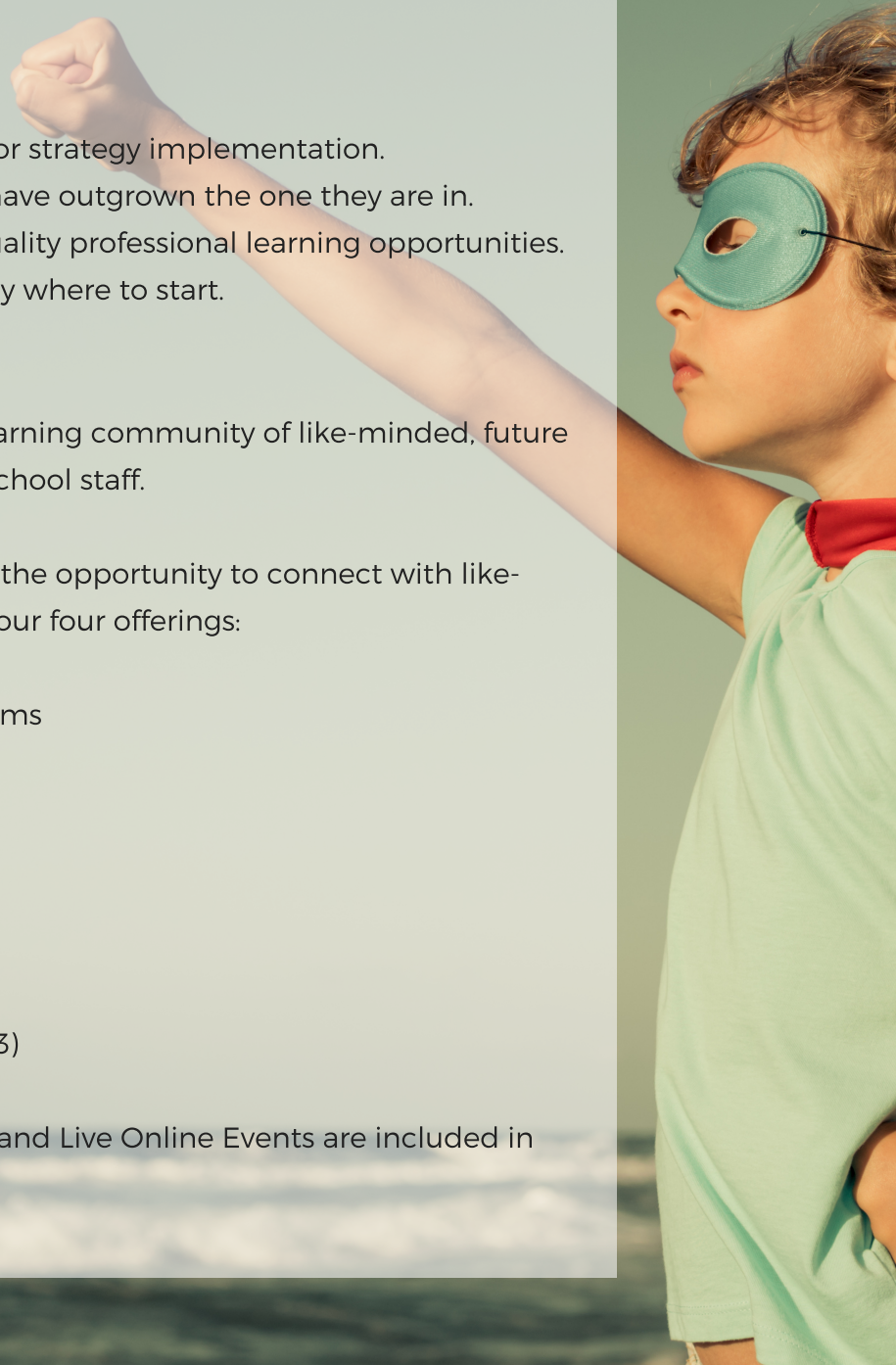
## What Do We Offer?

## LIVE ONLINE EVENTS

## PROFESSIONAL LEARNING FOR LEADERSHIP TEAMS

These tailored professional learning offerings for Principals & Leadership teams are designed to build leadership capacity to support your school's innovation journey. These are all included in the annual membership.

Delivered each semester, each professional learning is delivered as a series and provides an opportunity to develop professional networks with other leaders in the Future Schools Learning Community.

These include:

- **Leading an Adaptive School Culture** (six-part series): Hosted by David Runge, Director of Culture & Innovation. A cultural evolution and innovation framework uniquely designed to support educators who are leading cultural change.
- **Thought Leader in Residence** (three-part series): Hosted by Peter Hutton, Director of Educational Transformation and designed for Principals, the Thought Leader in Residence series hosts three sessions a semester.
- **Future Leaders, New Paradigms** (four-part series): Hosted by Jen Buchanan, Convenor of Community. A program available for staff in leadership positions to present findings or emerging trends in the future of schooling.



# FAQ: ONLINE EVENTS & MEMBERSHIP

## 1) Can my staff attend all of the live online events?

Yes! Online live events - including Webinars, Virtual School Tours and Keynote presentations by Future Schools leaders, are held every Tuesday during term time. At the beginning of each term, we share a sign up form with our schools. Staff simply choose which events they would like to receive a zoom calendar invite for. All events are recorded, so can be watched at a later date.

\$4480 (Ex GST) billed annually in the term your school joins Future Schools.

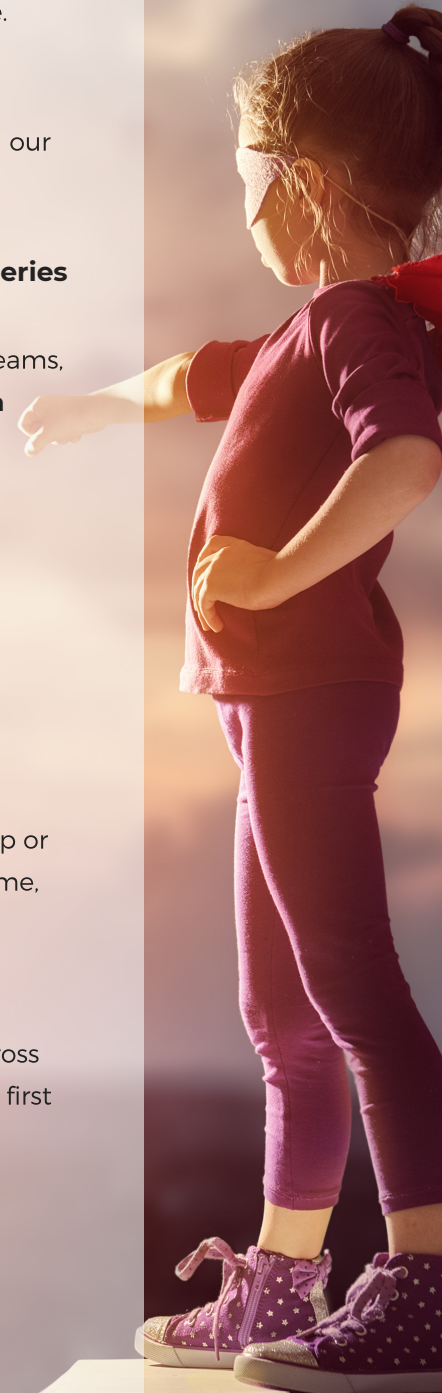
## 5) How do I manage my membership?
