These tailored professional learning offerings for Principals & Leadership teams are designed to build leadership capacity to support your school's innovation journey. These are all included in the annual membership.


These include:

1) Can my staff attend all of the live online events?

Yes! Online live events - including Webinars, Virtual School Tours and Keynote presentations by Future Schools leaders, are held every Tuesday during term time. At the beginning of each term, we share a sign up form with our schools. Staff simply choose which events they would like to receive a zoom calendar invite for. All events are recorded, so can be watched at a later date.
